VISITOR PASS – TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1) AUTHORITY

- a) Visitor Passes are issued at the Administration Building or online at the address above, by Wastewater personnel on Monday-Friday, 8:00 am to 4:45 pm, with the exception of Holidays. A pass is required for any and all activities on the premises and is from **Dawn to Dusk**.
- b) Day Passes are issued for the day. Day passes can be issued for the weekend and are usually issued on the Friday before.
- c) Annual Passes are issued or rejected based on review by the Safety and Technical Coordinator. Annual passes are not issued for Scouting in advance of hunting.
- d) Wastewater currently has contracts for site access with:
 - i) Muskegon Astronomical Society
 - ii) Muskegon Community College (Astronomy)
 - iii) Port City Model Aviation Club
 - iv) Muskegon Michigan Area Rocketry
 - v) Michigan's Edge Mountain Biking Association
 - vi) West Michigan Area RC Club
 - vii) Westshore Snowmobile Council

The MUSKEGON COUNTY BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS (BPW) – APPROVES ALL WASTEWATER COMMUNITY ON-SITE ACTIVITIES AND PROGRAMS

2) PERMISSIBLE ACTIVITIES INCLUDE:

- a) Bird Watching
- b) Hiking
- c) Photography
- d) Group Activities as above
- e) Wildlife Observation
- f) Bike Riding
- g) Cross Country Ski or Snowshoe (Established Trails Only)
- h) Hunting/Trapping (With Appropriate Separate Wastewater Permit)

3) PROHIBITED:

- a) Horses
- b) Motorized Recreational Vehicles
- c) Unleashed Pets
- d) Feeding or Spooking Wildlife
- e) Littering
- f) Sledding

4) SAFETY/RESPONSIBILITIES

- a) All visits are at your own risk
- b) Please refrain from interruption of Wastewater site activities/operations
- c) Drive carefully & responsibly- **DO NOT** Block Roadways
- d) Adhere to posted regulations
- e) Seasonal roads are not plowed
- f) Remain on established roads
- g) If your vehicle becomes stuck, you are responsible for arranging assistance. Wastewater cannot use County personnel or equipment for retrieval

5) DISPUTES/DISTURBANCES

- a) Any Visitor that witnesses or is a part of an issue/concern while on the site, we ask that you stop by the Administration Building to document the event.

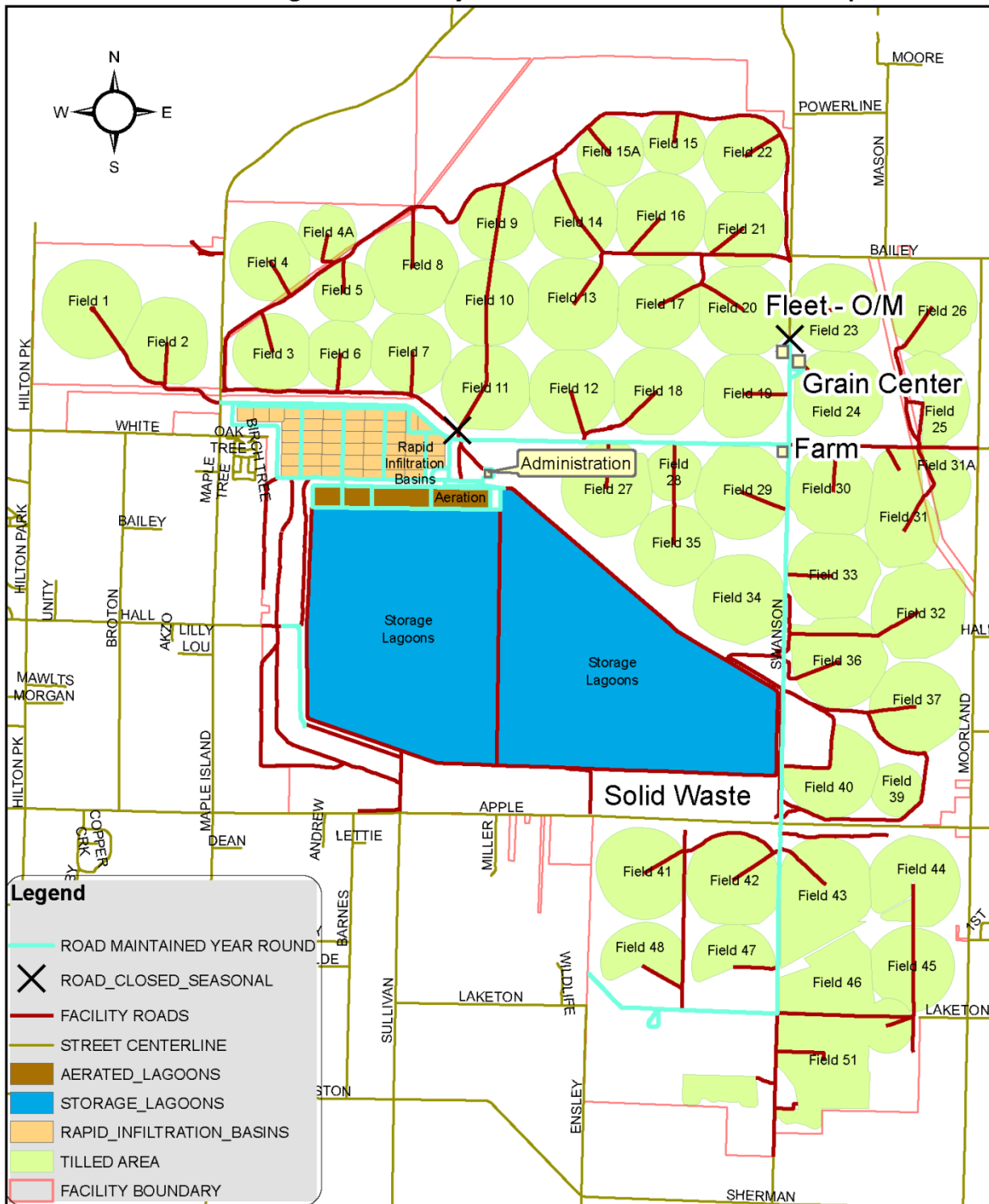
6) REVOCATION

- a) Any site use that is deemed by Wastewater or law enforcement staff as illegal, unsafe, disruptive or in violation of the Terms and Conditions, may result in revocation of the visitor pass, prosecution or both.
