MUSKEGON COUNTY RESOURCE RECOVERY CENTER ARCHERY DEER, ARCHERY TURKEY, ARCHERY COYOTE HUNTING RULES

ABSOLUTELY NO FIREARMS ALLOWED

Recreational Trespass conviction carries a penalty of up to 90 days in jail and fine of up to \$500

PROCEDURE

Permit Issuance

The Permit sale will consist of two stages:

Stage 1: Qualifying Draw

- 1. Each prospective hunter will submit their Name, Driver's License Number, MDNR 2025 Hunting License number, contact information, and Hunting Zone preference (see attached map) for a qualification drawing.
- Entries may be made in person at the Administrative offices during normal business hours, online at
 <u>MCResourceRecoveryCenter.com</u>, by email to <u>Wastewater@muskegoncounty.net</u>, or by postal mail using
 the form provided in these rules.
- 3. Each entrant will be assigned a number that will serve as their ID for the random drawing.
- 4. **Deadline** for entry will be **11:59 P.M., Tuesday, September 2, 2025**. Late entries will not be considered.
- 5. One entry form for each hunter, including minors. Duplicate entries will not be considered.
- 6. A random drawing will be held at 1:00 P.M., Thursday, September 4, 2025, to establish a roster of participants for the hunt and assign Hunting Zones. The location for the drawing will be Marquette Campus Administration Conference Room, 1903 Marquette Avenue.
- 7. Observers are welcome at the drawing.
- 8. Hunting Zones will be assigned based on availability of the applicant's most preferred Zone at the time of drawing. If the applicant does not include a level of preference for all Zones and their preferred Zone(s) are unavailable when they are drawn, then the applicant will forfeit their opportunity to purchase a permit.
- 9. Each successful applicant will be notified of their success and zone assignment by telephone.
- 10. Prepayment of permit fees will be encouraged. Cash, Credit Card (2.5% fee) or Check accepted. No refunds will be issued.
- 11. ALL successful applicants MUST appear at 9:00 A.M. on Wednesday, September 10, 2025 at the Marquette Campus Administration Conference Room, 1903 Marquette Avenue.
- 12. **ONLY** those physically present at the final drawing sessions and possessing the appropriate identification, will be considered for permit purchase.

Stage 2: Presentation and Permit Pickup

- 13. A valid 2025 -2026 MDNR Hunting License and photo ID must be presented at the time of permit purchase. Each hunter must be present to purchase a permit (exception: purchase for a minor).
- 14. At the on-site drawing session, the Hunting Rules will be verbally presented to all.
- 15. ONE permit and one Zone per hunter -An adult may purchase for a minor but that minor must have been a

- successful entrant to be eligible.
- 16. Each purchaser must complete a Waiver form, supply their Driver's License, Hunting License and Proof of Service, if a Veteran (valid DD-214, Active Duty Military ID, or Muskegon County Veteran ID).
- 17. If any permits remain after the Permit Pickup, they will be sold to alternates identified in the initial drawing.
- 18. NO exceptions to these drawing rules.
- 19. Permit holder may **ONLY** hunt in **the selected zone** for the entire season. Hunting outside the assigned zone will result in permit revocation and possible prosecution.

<u>Permit Fees:</u> \$100.00 for the period from October 1, 2025 continuous through January 1, 2026

Military Veterans w/ valid DD-214 or ID Card: No Charge

Turkey Season is from September 15 through November 14, 2025. Coyote Season is from October 1, 2025 through April 15, 2026

NO REFUNDS!

Hours for hunting shall be one-half hour before sunrise until one-half hour after sunset, daily (one-half hour before sunset for Turkey). Hours of admittance shall include a reasonable amount of time before and after hunting hours to accommodate setup and takedown activities. Any judgment on admittance times shall be determined by law enforcement officials or county staff on a case-by-case basis.

Access will be from the gates on Apple Ave. and Maple Island Rd. Hunters are restricted to travel on **designated hunting roads** as shown on the attached map.

Parking is the hunter's liability and must be off, but within close proximity of, all roads, not disrupt Wastewater System operations, and not be in the way of irrigation rig towers and drop pipes (to avoid vehicle damage).

Scouting is allowed in advance of the season for hunters that have been issued permits, but 'shining' is prohibited. Scouting will only be permitted in your registered zone after October 1st.

GENERAL RULES

- 1. The **hunting areas** are depicted on the attached map. Hunting is **not** permitted in the restricted areas. Hunting shall be allowed in the designated areas by <u>PERMIT only</u>. No hunting is permitted on Wastewater property outside the fenced areas (such as north of the fence next to Mosquito Creek). Any questions should be directed to County staff or the Sheriff's Deputy.
- 2. Archery hunting during the firearm season is subject to all state rules in effect during the firearm season and must be followed (e.g., must wear hunter orange).
- 3. All hunters shall possess and exhibit a valid and applicable Michigan hunting license, a valid Wastewater permit, and display the Wastewater tag in the window of their vehicle clearly visible from the outside. Each hunter must possess their own Wastewater hunting permit.
- 4. Hunters' equipment and tag shall be subject to inspection at all times by County staff.
- 5. <u>No permanent blinds or permanent tree stands</u> will be allowed; however, temporary portable blinds or portable stands will be permitted. **All temporary blinds and stands must be removed every day.**
- 6. No target practice will be permitted within the hunting areas.
- 7. No arrows shall be discharged within **50** feet of the fenced boundaries of the site.
- 8. No arrows shall be discharged within 500 feet of any building or mechanical structure, including, but not limited to, exposed pipes, spray irrigation rigs, pumps, etc.

- 9. No hunting is permitted in areas where harvest or construction activities are in progress.
- 10. All hunting shall be subject to all applicable laws of the State of Michigan, which shall be strictly enforced.
- 11. Any person who damages any County property shall be liable for such damage.
- 12. Violation of these rules by any hunter shall result in the immediate revocation of the permit, and the hunter shall be subject to expulsion from the area as a trespasser as well as prosecution for violating the same or other applicable laws. Revocation of one's permit may result in ineligibility for hunting access in subsequent years.
- 13. No littering shall be permitted. No bottles or cans will be allowed in the area. No alcoholic beverages are permitted on site at any time.
- 14. <u>No driving of deer</u> is permitted by any means or method. This includes individuals or groups on foot or in vehicles.
- 15. No "Road Hunting" is permitted. All hunting shall occur from a **fixed location, such as a blind or stand**. Stalking is prohibited.
- 16. No firearms on person or in the vehicle shall be permitted at any time.
- 17. No Off-Road Vehicles are permitted on site. Those requiring additional access due to physical disability must contact staff at 231-724-3441, for special permissions and arrangements.

WILD TURKEY HUNTING

Archery hunting of wild turkey will be permitted during the fall season under these rules at no extra fee. The taking of wild turkey shall be subject to all state and county regulations. All archery deer hunting regulations stated in these rules shall also apply. **The hunter must possess appropriate public land permit valid for this zone.**

ARCHERY COYOTE HUNTING

Archery hunting of coyote will be permitted under these rules at no extra fee. The taking of coyote shall be subject to all state and county regulations. In addition **NO DOGS WILL BE PERMITTED FOR COYOTE HUNTING.** Hunting hours shall be one half hour before sunrise to one half hour after sunset. All archery deer hunting regulations stated in these rules shall also apply. **The hunter must possess appropriate licenses.**

CONDITIONS

Each hunter shall be liable for any injury or death to persons or damage to property. The County shall not be liable for the recklessness or carelessness of other hunters. Every person shall use reasonable care for his or her own safety.


The County does not represent or guarantee that any game taken from the Wastewater Site is fit for human consumption. Each hunter should carefully examine the game for evidence of illness or disease in the same manner as game from other areas would be examined if used for human consumption.

The permit is granted for archery deer hunting, archery turkey hunting, and archery coyote hunting (as set forth above) purposes only. No other game hunting is permitted by these rules.

The County reserves the right to alter or amend these rules and regulations at any time if circumstances so require. No refunds of permit or other fees will be given.

The County will have a Sheriff's Deputy assigned to monitor the bow hunt again this year. Please report any observance of violations to the Deputy or County staff.
